What do we use your child's data for?



The **University of Hull** uses your child's data to help us plan, monitor and evaluate any outreach activity your child takes part in that is solely or partly funded by us. This lets us keep an eye on how successful our activities are and understand progression through education.

This data will be held in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and processed as a task carried out in the public interest as a University (i.e. supporting and widening participation in higher education).



Information about ethnicity is a special category of personal data, and we require it for academic research purposes carried out in the public interest.



The data will be stored on a secure database (the Higher Education Access Tracker) and kept in line with their data retention policy.

HEAT may share data with other national teams to help track their progress through education. These are: UCAS, OfS, HESA, DfE, ESFA.

What information do we need?

Nice and easy, we ask for the following bits of data to be shared with us about your child:

- first name
- gender
- school / college
- last name
- ethnicity
- specific details if relevant
(i.e. if they are a young carer / in care / care leaver / service child)
- date of birth
- postcode
