Dear parent / carer

We are pleased to announce that we are planning a trip to Spain for our students in Year 12 as part of their Spanish, Art or Photography studies, which will take place in February/March 2028. At this stage, we are seeking expressions of interest before we confirm whether the trip will go ahead.

As yet, dates are unconfirmed, but the trip would depart over a weekend, and students will be absent from school for two days. Absence from school would be authorised.

Our days will be filled with cultural experiences which may include tapas making/tasting, art museums and a flamenco show.

The cost of the trip is approximately £950 (subject to change depending on numbers, dates and flights). Please note the trip is an 'optional extra' under the 1996 Education Act" and the school is therefore permitted to charge for this activity.

The price includes:

- All travel in Spain, including flights
- Three nights' accommodation
- Two meals per day whilst in Spain
- All activities
- Insurance

Please note the price **does not** include travel to the airport and would be the responsibility of parents. Students would need to have money to buy their lunches each day and provide their own spending money.

Students will require a passport that meets all rules and regulations for travel to Spain and a European health card.

If you are interested in attending this trip, please complete the expression of interest form here. The deadline for your expression of interest is **12:30pm** on **Wednesday 3 December 2025**.

Please be aware that submitting the form does not guarantee your child a place on the trip, it is merely to ascertain numbers of students interested and whether the trip is viable to go ahead. Attendance, behaviour and attitude to learning will be considered when allocating places, in the interests of all of those travelling.
