We are excited to inform you that your child has been selected to take part in the Brake Kids Walk on **Tuesday 10 June 2025**.

This activity is a great way for us to highlight road safety and raise funds to help the Brake Charity campaign for safe and healthy journeys, and support families affected by road accidents. The main aim of Brake's Kids Walk is to promote the health and planet-saving benefits of walking. It's also a great way to raise awareness among parents and the local community about protecting children on our roads.

On average, more than six children are killed or seriously injured on roads in Britain every day – that is equivalent to a whole class of children every single week. We are doing our bit to try and make sure this never happens in our community. You can help us by continuing to teach your child road safety.

Students will be taken in the school minibus to Penshurst Primary School, where they will join our primary pupils as they walk down Winthorpe Road, along First Lane, up Boothferry Road, through to Penshurst Avenue and then back into Penshurst Primary School; we will then return to Hessle High School on the school minibus.
