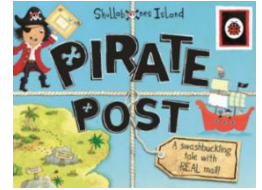


Ahoy Me Hearties

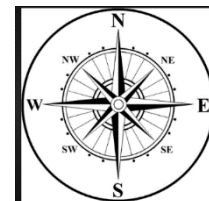


Key Vocabulary

Bilge	The lowest part of the ship.



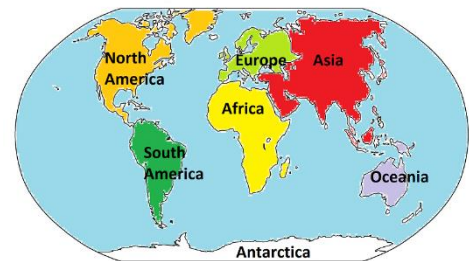
The **Jolly Roger** flag warned pirate's victims to surrender without a fight!
