A source of information and resources to support careers education and progression for the local area (Hull, East Riding of Yorkshire and the North Yorkshire coast) is a website called www.logonmoveon.co.uk. The website includes an online prospectus of local education and training opportunities after Year 11.

Your child will shortly be receiving a username and password to access their learner account on www.logonmoveon.co.uk. They will receive this via their school email address from 'eprospectus'. They will be able to retain and use this account until Year 14, adding to it as they progress regardless of which post 16 options they choose.

Please support your child by ensuring they access both their learner account and the home learning career resources.

In their learner account:

- 1. Check their personal details on the 'Your Profile' section by September 2022
- 2. Complete the 'Your Next Step' section by September 2022
- 3. Start the Skills Passport; there is a step-by-step guide to help
- 4. Students will start working on their Curriculum Vitae using the CV writer to assist during the year 10 Careers Week

On the main website pages (www.logonmoveon.co.uk):

- Learn about Labour Market Information, so they know what jobs are available and in which employment sectors, and future employment opportunities
- Learn about local education, training and apprenticeship opportunities 6.
- 7. Develop their general careers knowledge

From October 2022, your son/daughter can apply for their future post 16 destination via the website under 'Your Applications' once each section of their profile is complete. Ideally applications should be made between October half term and February half term.























Please note, the Year 10 Careers Week takes place w/c 27 June 2022, during this week there will be a wide variety of workshops delivered by post 16 providers and industry representatives and your child will be given a bespoke timetable which reflects the information they provided us with via their 'My Future' questionnaire. Your child will also be given the opportunity to take part in the Enterprise Day which is a business focussed competition to encourage entrepreneurship and develop employability skills.
