Dear Parent/Carer

I am writing to you regarding the high standards and expectations we have with regards to PE uniform and participation in PE lessons.

Students are required to have the following items for PE in line with the uniform policy:

**Indoor PE Kit**

- Royal blue polo shirt with school logo and house colours
- Royal blue shorts, white socks
- No outdoor shoes to be worn for indoor activities

**Outdoor PE Kit**

- Royal blue polo shirt with school logo and house colours
- Royal blue shorts
- Royal blue socks

**For colder outdoor weather lessons**

- It is recommended that students wear the royal blue hoodie with school logo and house colours, other hoodies or sweatshirts are not permitted
- Tracksuit bottoms may be worn as well as school kit, not instead of, and must be black

We understand that there are times when students may not be able to fully participate in their PE lesson, for example, due to an injury. However, we would expect them to contribute to the lesson by undertaking tasks such as officiating, scoring, identifying strengths and weaknesses of performance and helping to organise equipment. Therefore your child is required to bring their PE kit to the lesson in order to fully participate.

If your child is unable to undertake an active role in the lesson, we require them to bring a note explaining the reason why they cannot participate fully, in order that we can ensure we set appropriate tasks for them to do during the lesson. Please ensure any messages of this kind are reported to the school by telephone (voicemail is acceptable) or email before 8.30am.
