For the benefit of all concerned, please note the following;

- There will be no parking on site. Vehicles will only be allowed on site to drop off VIPs. Vehicles will follow a circuit around the visitor car park and drop off in the bus stop area on site.
- Parents who wish to see their child arrive, will be permitted on site on foot only. To avoid congestion on Heads Lane, please plan to arrive on foot or park well away from the school and
- NO ALCOHOL is permitted on site. We reserve the right to search anyone who we suspect of bringing alcohol onto the site. Anyone doing so or arriving in a state of inebriation will not be allowed to enter the Prom and parents will be required to collect them. This is to ensure the safety of all.
- The school site is a no smoking site and this will also be the case during the Prom.
- VIPs may not leave the site during the Prom. Once a VIP leaves, they will not be permitted to
