| Rey Dates  BC = Used to show that a date is before the year 0. This is counted backwards, so 200 BC is before 100 BC  AD = Used to show that a date is after the year 0. This is counted forwards, so AD 100 is before AD 200.  3500 BC | Tutankhamun Facts  Born: around 1342 BC  Died: around 1323 BC  Pharaoh from approx. 1333 BC to 1323 BC  Known as the 'boy king' as he became pharaoh aged only 9  Tomb discovered by Howard Carter and his team in the Valley of the Kings in 1922  Tomb contained over 3000 treasures  Historians believe Tutankhamun died suddenly as the tomb was finished hastily. | Embalming and Mummification  1. Wash the body. 2. Pull out the brain through the nostrils with a hook and fill the skull with sawdust. 3. Remove all internal organs except the heart. Put them into Canopic jars. 4. Cover the body in natron salt and leave it to dry for 40 days. 5. Remove the natron salt and pack the body with straw, dried grass or linen. 6. Apply makeup and fake eyes. 7. Wrap the body in linen fabric, adding amulets and a Book of the Dead. |
