Maths

In Maths this half term, we will be consolidating our skills in Shape, Space & Measure, as well as Fractions.

Literacy

This half term, we are writing a set of instructions as well as a Greek Myth.

Science

In Science, we will be continuing to learn about light and shadows.

History

Ancient Greeks will be the focus of our History lessons this half term. We will learn about them, compare life in Ancient Greece to life now, and learn about their legacies.

Geography

We will be using maps and globes in Geography to locate Greece and its islands.

Art / Design & Technology

In Art, we will be using charcoal to create a mythical creature. We will be creating moving Trojan Horses in DT.

RE

We will be thinking about all of the different times of remembering, such as Remembrance Day in RE this half term.

PSHE

Using our lead text as a springboard, we will be: looking at personal successes; understanding when it is necessary to seek help from others; covering rules and laws which govern us; and learning about the different cultural, ethnic and religious groups that make up the UK.

RSE

We will be visiting the most important characteristics of friendship, including mutual respect, truthfulness, trustworthiness, loyalty, kindness, generosity, trust, sharing interests and experiences and support with problems and difficulties.

PE

Hitting, catching and running skills will be the focus in PE this half term.

Computing

In computing this half term, we will be learning about emails and how to send them.

Music

Animal movement is linked with pitch in this unit in order to help children develop understanding and recognition of changing pitch.

Languages

This half term, we will be consolidating what we have learnt over the year in French, and using this in written sentences.

Global Awareness

Looking at the injustices that happen in our lead text, we will be studying Global Goal 16 - Peace, Justice and Strong Institutions.

South Africa Links

We will be researching the religions of South Africa and their Gods this half term.
