Maths

In Maths this half term, we are covering fraction, shape, space and measure in order to continue to build on basic mathematical concepts. There will also be a major focus on Times Tables in the lead up to the Multiplication Check in June.

Literacy

In Writing this half term, we will be writing a persuasive letter and a narrative.

Science

This term we are completing learning about Electricity before moving onto learning about Living Things and their Habitats. We will look at: exploring and using classification keys to help group, identify and name a variety of living things in our local and wider environment.

Geography

In Geography, we will focus on developing our map skills: looking at scale; understanding grid references; interpreting symbols; and following routes on an OS map.

Art & Design

We will be using sketchbooks to record observations and develop ideas. Additionally, we will be studying the artist Stephanie Peters and create a piece of work in her style.

Global Awareness

<u>RE</u>

This half term we will learn about the religious festivals of Eid and Wesak.

PSHE

We will be looking at how to manage money effectively and to understand that the media doesn't always portray the correct information.

RSE

We will learn about the importance of giving and receiving advice and how to effectively make a call to an emergency service.

<u>PE</u>

This half term we will learn how to run, jump and throw.

Computing

We start learning about spreadsheets and how to use formulas.

Music

Music Express - We will be performing with tuned and untuned instruments, using voice and learning key music vocabulary.

Languages

Through iLanguages, we will continue to learn phrases and words in Spanish.

We will be learning about the effect that climate change is having on parts of the world covered in snow and ice.
