Maths

This half term we will cover the following objectives: translation, solving problems with equivalent fractions, interpreting and drawing line graphs.

Literacy

This half term we will be writing a diary entry and a narrative.

Science

We will finish off our forces unit before moving onto our new unit, Animals Including Humans. Within this unit, we will learn about the human life cycle and the changes which occur during puberty.

Art and Design

We will be learning how to mix and match colours to create atmosphere and light effects.

Geography

We will learn to locate the position of the Tropics of Cancer and Capricorn, and the Greenwich Meridian on maps. In addition, we will also learn how to use latitude and longitude as well as learning about different time zones across the globe.

RE

We will be learning about Eid-al-Fitr and Wesak during our faith days.

PSHE

We will learn that rules and laws differ in different parts of the world.

RSE

We will learn that others' families may look different to our own and will learn to respect those differences. We will also be looking at our own feelings and actions and deciding if how we are behaving is appropriate and proportionate.

PE

In PE we will learn to run, jump and throw in athletics.

Computing

In our computing sessions, we will be learning how to create and use databases.

Music

Our unit this half term is called Environments. Within this unit we will learn a poem about the seasons and study songs about global warming.

Languages

This half term we will practise opinion phrases such as J'adore/ je deteste. We will also ask questions with c'est qui and extend sentences with et and aussi.

Global Awareness

We will be learning about Global Goal 13- Climate Action. In this lesson we will consider the effect that air travel has on our climate. We will then compare this to balloon travel / time travel and consider the advantages and disadvantages.
