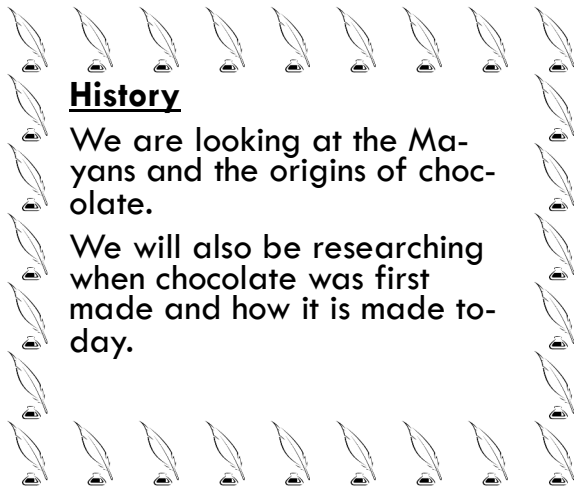




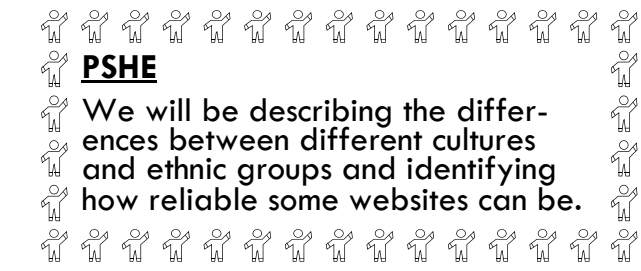

History

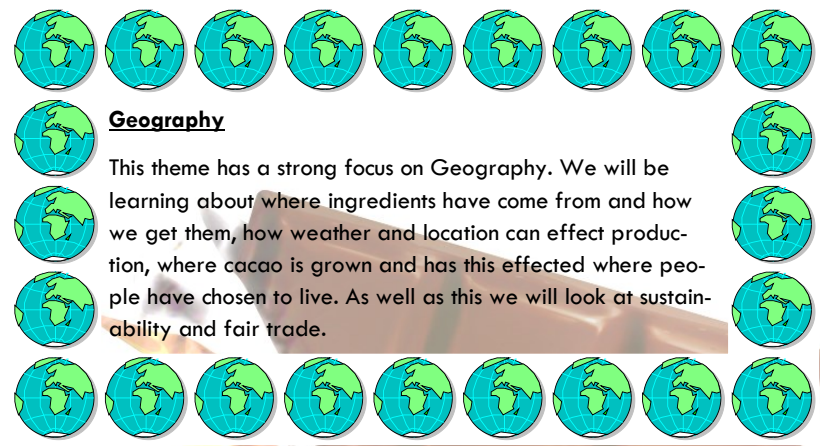
We are looking at the Mayans and the origins of chocolate.

Geography

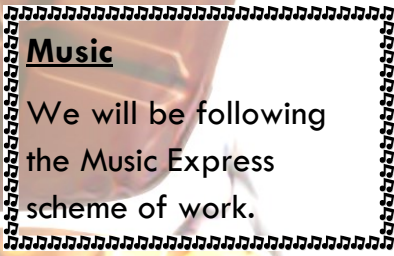

MFL

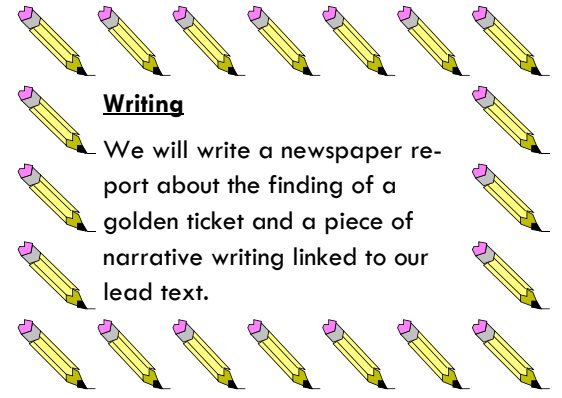
We will be following the iLanguages scheme of work focussing on Spanish.

Year 4 The Chocolate Room



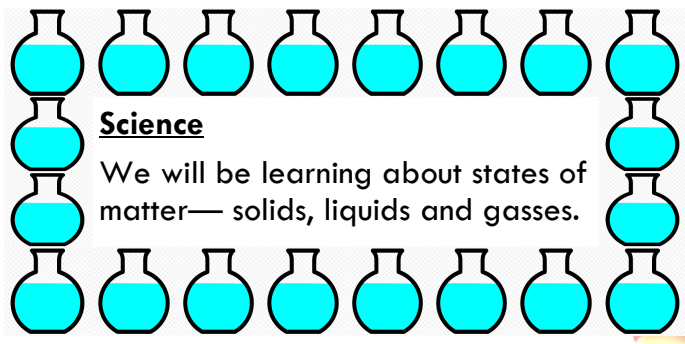
Music

We will be following the Music Express scheme of work.



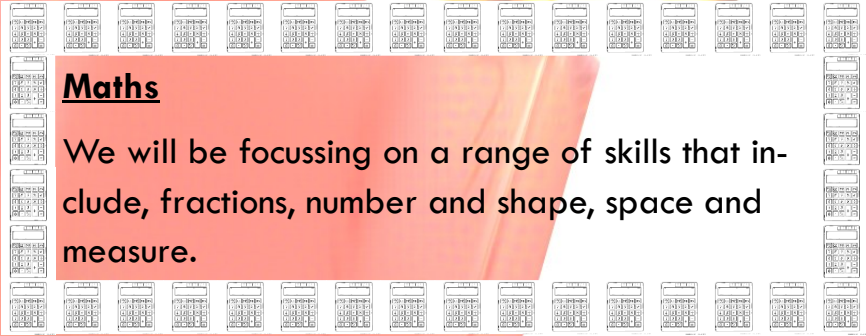
Writing

We will write a newspaper report about the finding of a golden ticket and a piece of narrative writing linked to our lead text.



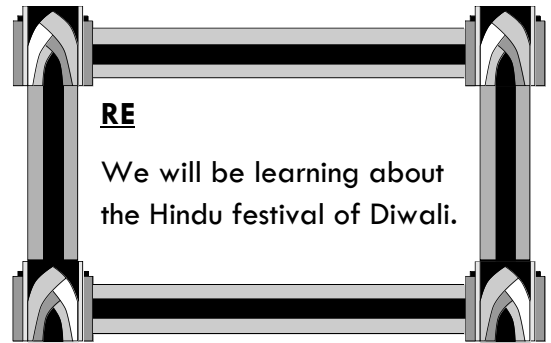
Science

We will be learning about states of matter— solids, liquids and gasses.



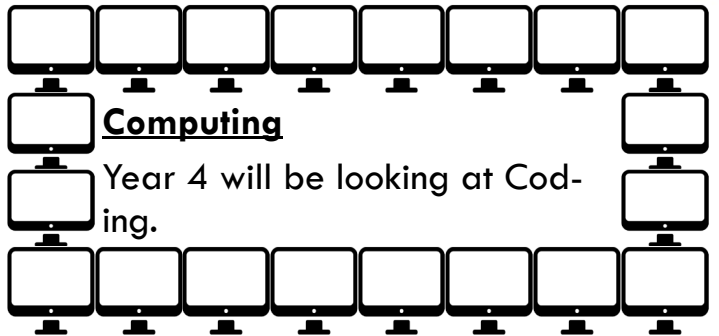
Maths
