Importance of Attendance

Attendance	Average Progress 8 Score
100%	+0.6
95%	+0.3
90%	-0.25
80%	-0.57
Below 80%	-2.55

- 132 days in Year 11 before exams begin
- One full week off plus one day off per month = 90%

Attendance Support



- Support parent/carers to perform their legal duty in ensuring that their children attend school regularly
- Work with HOY/AHOYs in supporting parents when students are struggling to attend regularly, creating excellent communication between all parties
- Reward excellent attendance and improved attendance
- Notify parents/carers at the earliest opportunity where attendance and punctuality is a concern.

Wellbeing and Support



As a Head of Year, I am responsible for the leadership of both the Year Group and their team of Tutors

- **Pastoral Care:** This is a primary responsibility and involves looking after the social, emotional, and mental well-being of the students. I will be involved in supporting issues such as bullying, social isolation, family problems, and work closely with school support agencies. ***This is a team approach with AHOY and wider pastoral team***
- **Academic Monitoring:** I monitor the academic progress of students, identifying those who are underachieving and assist in putting interventions in place. This can include setting up mentor programs, tutoring, or other academic supports.
- **Behaviour Management:** I address any disciplinary issues that arise, in collaboration with other school staff. This can involve setting up behaviour contracts, liaising with senior management, and implementing consequences.
- **Attendance Monitoring:** Track student attendance and punctuality, intervening when there are issues and liaising with parents and guardians as necessary.
- **Organising Events:** These include rewards trip, charity events, fundraising events and most importantly to the year 11 students...the Rewards PROM.
